Graduate students enrolled in Masters Degree and Ph.D. programs are encouraged to submit papers to the Graduate Student Paper Competition. The competition is open for complete papers ONLY (i.e. no paper proposals or abstracts) and must be received by June 1, 2017 in order to be considered for an award.

General instructions: Submission instructions will be included in the next CALL FOR PAPERS.

The submission process opens on March 15, 2017 and closes on **July 1, 2017**. Each submission must include the following information on the title page:

1. Title of submission.
2. Authors and their affiliations, including complete physical addresses, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses. In the case of multiple authors, all correspondence will be sent to the first author in the list unless otherwise requested.
3. Student classification, i.e. Masters or Ph.D.

Participant Obligation: The submission of a paper to the 2017 SEINFORMS Annual Meeting means that the author(s) agree to attend the meeting and present the paper. Only those authors who register to attend the meeting in advance of the publication date will have their papers published in the 2017 SEINFORMS Annual Meeting *Proceedings*.

Competition Details:

1. Each accepted and presented student paper will receive a \$100 Joanna Baker Memorial Travel Scholarship at the 2017 SEINFORMS Annual Meeting. Only ONE travel scholarship will be awarded for a paper with multiple authors.
2. Additional cash prizes will be awarded at the 2017 SEINFORMS Annual Meeting based on both the paper and the presentation at the conference.
3. Papers must be clearly identified as "Submitted to the Graduate Student Paper Competition" in order to be eligible for consideration.
